Early Childhood Intervention

 The purpose of this program is to provide comprehensive ECI Services for children birth to 36 months. Subrecipients will deliver individualized services to enrolled children and families that include, but are not limited to therapies, family education and support programs designed to address cognitive, physical, communication, social, and emotions emotional development. The expected outcomes for children participating in the ECI program include improved developmental milestones and increased readiness for school.
