1. Overview

This document describes the data elements and file format for the 11 csv files exported from provider tool and then uploaded into HHSC FVNET website.

The sections below define the categories in more detail and the order and data elements for each category.

2. File Naming Convention

File naming convention is defined to identify uniquely by provider name and reporting month. There are 11 different categories of data collected in 11 separate CSV files. File name consists of 3 parts separated by underscore.

Part 1	Month and Year of the data reported. Year is 4 digits Month should always be 2 digits. For Example, January should be entered as '01'
Part 2	Site short name of the reporting site. All upper case
Part 3	Name of Data Set. All upper case

File names are case sensitive. All letters should be in upper case.

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- Sites should provide client data for the below scenarios only:

 - If victimization is reported for that month;
 - If shelter days were provided for that month; or
 - If client assistance type was provided for that month.
- If the Data Element has a lookup table listed under ‘Possible Values’ column in the above table, then the code should be provided in the file.

- Sites will provide one victimization record per client if available.
- When a victimization is reported then it must have an accompanying record in the services file.
- HHSC would expect to have a victimization reported for each fiscal year, meaning if a client came for services in August and reported a victimization then that record would need to come over again in September for the new fiscal year assuming client is still getting services.
- If the Data Element has a lookup table listed under 'Possible Values' column in the above table, then the code should be provided in the file.

- There will be separate rows for each service type provided to a client. If the same service type is provided to the client on the same day, through the same channel and under the same HHSC type, it should appear in a single row with the 'Total Service Contacts' with the number of times that service type was provided on the same day, through the same channel and under the same HHSC type.
- All service types are allowable by all service channels except for "Enter Shelter" and "Exit Shelter" which must be provided Face to Face.
- If a client has a service, their information should also show up in Client.csv.
- If the Data Element has a lookup table listed under 'Possible Values' column in the above table, then the code should be provided in the file.

5.2 Support for Multiple Shelters and Hotel Stays

FVNET system supports data from multiple shelter locations in a single upload. There are changes to the .csv files formats and as well as the addition of new HHSC Types (previously known as Funding Sources). Below is a summary of the newly added and renamed HHSC Types and Non-HHSC Types:

HHSC Types

- Main location: HHSC Shelter (RES)
- Additional location: HHSC Shelter 2 (RES2) (previously HHSC Shelter A (RESA))
- Third additional location: HHSC Shelter 3 (RES3) (previously HHSC Satellite (SLITE))
- Clients staying in Hotels, Motels, or Safe Homes: HHSC Hotel (RESHTL)
- Clients staying in a shelter not funded by HHSC: Non-HHSC Shelter (NHRES)
